Who is this toolkit for?

This toolkit is designed to help community, health and social service organizations, lay health advisors (promotoras), YMCAs/YWCAs, fraternities, school organizations (e.g., PTAs/PTOs), senior centers, faith-based organizations, and others to share accurate information about COVID-19 vaccines and COVID-19 in their social media networks and educational channels, FDA official COVID-19 messages, to fight misinformation and vaccine hesitancy.

What is the purpose of this toolkit?

As large numbers of people have gotten vaccinated against COVID-19 during pandemic in the past months, it has become clear that special considerations and targeted messages are still needed to encourage some groups to get vaccinated and fight vaccine misinformation.


